Graduation Requirements

To earn the BS degree you must successfully complete the liberal studies, aviation and business requirements; your cumulative GPA at the time of graduation must be at least a 2.50. **Note**: When you apply for graduation with the BS degree, if your GPA is not at or above the minimum 2.50, we will automatically move you to the Bachelor of Arts (BA) in Business Studies major program, which has a GPA requirement of 2.0, so that you can still earn a Business degree. To avoid being moved to the BA Business Studies degree (if your GPA is <2.50 at the time you apply for graduation), you can change your major to **one outside of the School of Business prior to applying for graduation; but you cannot be awarded the any Bachelor of Science (BS) degree if you do not meet the minimum 2.50 GPA requirement.**

Curriculum Matrix and Off-Site Coursework/Fees

The sample curriculum matrix for the BS degree follows. For the BS degree, a total of 27 credits of study, identified as courses with an AVBM prefix (Courses: AVBM 110, 111, 120, 121, 210, 211, 212, 311 and 312) are instructed by and held at Fundamentals Flight Training facility located at 1605 Asbury Road, Erie, PA 16506. These courses are held face-to-face, and additional fees apply to them. Additionally, students in the BS degree program may be able to substitute (up to) 6 credits of coursework during their Senior year for a Co-op experience placement at FFT (ABVM 395, 396).
